Re: Year 8 Slavery Workshop: The National Maritime Museum, Greenwich; Tuesday 21st November 2017

As part of their History curriculum, Year 8 will be studying slavery. To enhance their learning, we are offering a visit to the prestigious National Maritime Museum in Greenwich, where students will handle real and replica artefacts from the time of slavery and be guided through the story that these pieces of history tell by an expert curator and historian.

Students must attend in full academy uniform and bring a packed lunch. There will not be an opportunity to buy food. Dressing appropriately for the weather will be important, as students and staff will walk 5-10 minutes from Greenwich train station to the museum.

Students will need to meet staff at Dartford train station directly at 8:30 a.m. Staff and students will then return on a train due to arrive in Dartford at 3:43 p.m.

We would ask you to indicate on the reply slip printed below, whether you will be collecting your child from the train station or allowing them to make their own way home.

The cost of the visit is £6.00. Current legislation permits us to ask only for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the visit. No student will be discriminated against on the inability to pay. However, if sufficient money is not raised through contributions, then the visit will have to be cancelled. Full payment is required by Thursday 19th October 2017 and we suggest that students bring no more than £5 spending money to use in the gift shop.
