



Dress Code

The Academy works in close partnership with the local community, business and industry; therefore Post 16 students will observe the dress code at all times.

Male Students

Tailored trousers, shirt and tie.
Shoes.
Denim and Trainers are not permitted.

Female Students

Tailored trousers or skirt.
or
Dress with shoes.

Off the shoulder, halter neck, thin-strapped tops and miniskirts, are considered unsuitable. Midriffs must be covered and tailored trousers must be full length and of matching material and colour. **Leggings, Trainers, Denim or Leather** garments are also not considered acceptable and could result in students being refused entry to the Academy.

Appearance

Hair should be of a natural colour.
Students who must wear different clothing (such as labcoats or sportswear) for a subject-specific reason are asked to bring a change of clothing in for that purpose. When outside that lesson, normal business dress must again be worn, including at arrival to and departure from the Academy. DFC students must follow Academy dress code at all times inside the building.

This list is a guide only and students will wish to interpret this guidance in their own way. However, if staff feel that an element of a student's appearance is inappropriate, we reserve the right to send a student home to correct it.

All students must wear their Identity Card, on the appropriate College coloured lanyard. This card must be visible at all times and will be required for them to register using the swipe system when they enter or exit the building.
