SPANISH LANGUAGE TOUR TO BARCELONA 14th -17th July 2017

Dear Parent/Carer

We are excited to be proposing a school tour to Barcelona to support our curriculum plans for Spanish Language students and enhance learning experiences within the school.

Here are the key details about the planned trip:

- 4 days and 3 nights
- Departs on 14 July 2017
- Returns on 17 July 2017
- The purpose of the trip is to practise the Spanish they are studying in lessons
- The provisional cost is £520.00 per student
- This price includes:
 - Return flights and airport transfers
 - Group travel insurance
 - NST 24hr emergency contact service whilst on tour
 - Accommodation
 - Hotel Alberg Pere Tarres,
 - C/Numancia
 - 08029 Barcelona
 - Spain
- The group size is 40 students
- The adults accompanying the group will be to a ratio of 1:10 and will include Mr Dearsley DOL for MFL, Miss Picazo, Spanish teacher and two other members of staff.

The itinerary for the trip will include visits to the Nou Camp football stadium, the world famous Sagrada Familia cathedral, the Picasso museum and a tapas tasting evening. Entrance to these places is included in the tour price.

In addition to the tour cost, we recommend that your child has £15 per day spending money for the trip. They will need to buy their own lunch on each day of the visit. They will also require a current passport and an EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) card.

To secure a place for your son/daughter on this trip, a non-refundable deposit of £80.00 is required, along with the completed permission slip by Wednesday, October 12th. A further payment of £80.00 by December 1st is required followed by a final payment of £360 by May 5th 2017. Interim payments can be made between the dates outlined above.

The trip is being booked through NST Travel, the UK's leading educational travel company for schools with more than 45 years' experience. They work closely with us during the whole tour planning process to ensure that your child will get the very best learning experience whilst away.

Payment needs to be made through Parent Pay or in cash via Paypoint. To arrange payment via Pay Point please contact Mrs M O'Connor for a unique barcoded letter, on



Students will leave The Leigh Academy at approximately 6:00a.m. on Friday, 14th July and return by 10:00p.m. on Monday, July 17th. All students should bring a packed lunch with them for the outward journey. There will be a parent pre trip meeting in June before the visit.

Current legislation permits us to ask only for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the visit. No student will be discriminated against on the inability to pay. However, if sufficient money is not raised through contributions, then the visit will have to be cancelled.
