Dear Parents/Carers

**RE: PARENT-TUTOR DAY
WEDNESDAY 19TH OCTOBER 2016 for Years 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13**

We would like to invite you to our Parent-Tutor Day, which takes place on Wednesday 19th October 2016. This Parent-Tutor Day plays a crucial part in the success of your child, and affords us the opportunity of working together to review progress to date, to address any issues and to make plans for the future to support your child. **Please note that the Academy will be closed on this day for normal lessons.**

As such we expect that **all** students be represented on this day by one, or both, parents/carers. It is also expected that **all** students should accompany their parents/carers in correct Academy uniform, or business dress, if Post 16. If for any particular reason you are unable to attend, it is an expectation that an alternative appointment will be made on a different day, or at the very least, a telephone call to take place with your daughter/son's Tutor.

The Academy year is divided into six Modules and reports are issued at the end of each Module. At your appointment with your daughter/son's Tutor you will be able to discuss their end of Module 1 Report and the progress they have made so far this year and to consider strategies and targets for the year ahead.

Accessing your child's report

All reports are published onto ePortal on the homepage on the academy website. To access your child's report, simply click on the tab labelled "student reports", follow the ePortal link and log in in the usual way. If you have any issues with logging in, please contact your child's College Admin Assistant (details on the website).

Making an appointment

We would be grateful if you would indicate, on the slip attached, the times within which you will be able to attend an appointment, with your daughter/son's Tutor. Once the Tutor has received all reply slips, she/he will arrange the day and allocate you a specific 15-minute period of time. The time of this appointment will be communicated to you through your daughter/son in the diary section of their student planner and the appointments will take place in the student's Tutor room in each College.

It is likely that between 4.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. Tutors will be very busy. If you are in a position to arrange your appointment in the morning, or early afternoon, it would help to ease congestion and would make matters more convenient for you.


