Dear Parents/Carer

I write to remind you of two important events that are taking place this module. Firstly, Year 10 students will be sitting their GCSE English Literature papers on the 22nd and 26th May. An examination timetable for this has been given out to students with the timings and venue.

In addition to this, Year 10 students will be sitting Science examinations on the 2nd, 3rd and 4th May, which are mock examinations run by Edexcel to allow national moderation of outcomes for the new 9-1 GCSE. They do not count towards final grades but are important for the students and school to judge progress against a national perspective. All exams last for one and a half hours. Biology is on the 2nd May and covers units 1-4, Chemistry is on the 3rd May and covers units 1 and 2, and Physics is on the 4th May and covers units 1-5. Students need to be in the Lecture Theatre at 08:30a.m. to be registered prior to each exam. All information and revision support can be found in the Google Classroom **i83db**.
