Travel to Normandy 3rd July 2017

- Students will be expected to be at The Academy at 5:15a.m. on Monday, 3rd July. Students should load their main luggage onto the coach by 5.30a.m.
- Care should be taken not to pack anything in this bag which will be needed before our arrival in France, e.g., pocket money / medication / passport / EHIC card / packed lunch.
- Students should ensure their hand luggage contains everything they will need during the journey e.g., food, drinks, games, pen, pencil. The coach will have a DVD player so please bring any age appropriate DVDs you wish to watch.

Food for the journey to France

Students will need a packed lunch and other snacks. There will be an opportunity to buy food on the ferry but this can be expensive. Please do not provide your child with fizzy or energy drinks or cans. We recommend fruit juice or water in cartons or plastic bottles. Please do not send any food containing nuts, as there are people with a nut allergy on this trip.

Food for the journey back to England

Students will be provided with breakfast on the day of departure but must buy their food for the rest of the day. You may wish to remind your son/daughter to keep some money in reserve for the journey home.

Pocket money, mobile phones, devices and other valuables

Please ensure that most of your child's pocket money is in Euros before the trip, a small amount of English money might be useful. Students may keep their pocket money themselves but must understand that it is **their** responsibility. At the trip meeting in April it was suggested that £30 would be adequate.

Mobile phones are allowed on the trip. Again these are the responsibility of the individual student. This week roaming charges across Europe have ceased, so your normal UK tariff should apply in France.

iPads and tablets are **not** covered under the insurance policy provided by the travel company, so if allowing your child to take theirs with them, please arrange a separate insurance policy. A European travel adaptor will be necessary for charging devices.

Passports may be handed in to staff for safekeeping once we are in France. Staff will have access to a safe at our accommodation.

Medication

Medication, including travel sickness tablets, should be clearly labelled with the student's name and explicit instructions as to when and how it is to be administered. It should be handed to the group leader on the coach.

Travel Sickness Tablets

If you know or suspect your son/daughter may suffer from travel sickness please provide them with enough suitable medication. We are on the coach for some long journeys and your son/daughter could be very uncomfortable if you do not take adequate precautions.
