# Physical Education - Kit and Valuables Policy



1. All students are required to bring & wear the appropriate kit to each and every lesson if they are participating or not.
2. Students who are injured or unable to participate physically in a lesson must bring a note excusing them from the lesson ***in addition to bringing and wearing their kit.*** Students excused from practical participation in a lesson will still accompany the lesson and be the responsibility of the teacher leading the lesson.
3. It is strongly recommended that students do not bring valuables to PE lessons. In the event of that being unavoidable it is the student's responsibility to ensure that they are handed in to the teacher leading the lesson at the beginning of the lesson. The PE Learning Area will not be responsible for items not handed in or stolen.
4. The wearing of jewellery, wrist bands and watches whilst playing sport is potentially extremely harmful not only to the performer themselves but also those around them.
5. In the interest of personal safety any student with long hair performing in sport is required to tie back their hair so that vision and hearing is not impaired.
