



iPad Scheme – Frequently Asked Questions

Finance

How long can I spread the payments over?

12, 24 or 36 months depending on how long your child has left at the Academy. The term you select must end at the same time or before your child reaches the end of Year 11.

What happens at the end of the agreement?

On your final payment the device becomes yours.

Will there be any credit checks?

No, everyone is approved and there are no credit checks.

What is the excess on the insurance?

There is no excess on either the insurance or warranty. You will receive the BT helpline number with your device.

What happens if I miss a payment or can no longer afford the iPad?

You will have to return the iPad; you will not own the iPad until the final payment is made.

What happens if I cannot afford to join the scheme?

Each College will have a number of iPads that can be borrowed to use in lesson time, these devices will be kept in The Academy and given out when the learning requires. Students will not be able to take these devices home.

If your child is eligible or has been eligible for free school meals in the last 6 years, is a Looked After Child or has been adopted, or is a child of a parent in the forces they are entitled to a subsidised iPad and you will be given details of how to register for your iPad and the costs involved.

Practicalities

How do I order my child's iPad ?

You can order your child's iPad from **Wednesday 5th July – 6th August 2017** with delivery of the iPad at the beginning of September 2017.

Will my child be able to take the iPad home?

If you join the scheme and continue to make monthly payments the device will travel to and from the Academy with your child.

Will my child be safe travelling to and from school with their iPad?

We will advise all students that iPads should be in bags and away from sight on the way to and from school.

How many iPads can I order?

You will be allowed to order one iPad for every child you have at the Academy.

How will my child charge their iPad?

This will need to be done at home ready for the start of the Academy day.

What do I do if the iPad breaks?

You report the breakage directly to the BT helpline and they will register your claim and arrange for the device to be fixed. You should also advise the Academy that the iPad is being repaired.
